

# Meet Our Speaker Fr. TREVOR NATHASINGH

Father Trevor Nathasingh was ordained to the Holy Priesthood in 1989, for the Archdiocese of Port of Spain, Trinidad.

Fr. Trevor is a convert from a Hindu/ Muslim background and is now a Catholic Christian for over 30 years. Fr. Trevor has developed a charism for preaching and teaching and is one of the foremost Caribbean Catholic Evangelists. He is very involved in speaking at crusades, missions, revivals and Life in the Spirit Seminars, both locally and abroad. He is also the founder and coordinator of a lay community "Franciscan House of Prayer" which has a ministry of preaching, evangelization and a home for children.

His Conversion came about through the ministry of his home parish prayer group. He responded to the call of or Lord, while living as a covenanted member of a Lay Charismatic Community. The Charismatic Renewal is home to Fr. Trevor, and his travels and preaching is about motivating his brothers and sisters into living the faith. He has opened the doors for Intergeneration Healing through Healing Masses, and pioneered Open Air Crusades (new to the Roman Catholic Church) in Trinidad and Grenada.

He has dedicated his life of service as Priest, "to proclaim without compromise the action of the Holy Spirit at work in the Church today". He is highly respected by lay and clergy alike.
